AN ACT additional to chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to fishing in Simpson pond, so-called, in the town of Roque Bluffs, in the County of Washington.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

No person shall fish for, take, catch or kill any trout at  
2 any time in Simpson pond, so-called, in the town of Roque  
3 Bluffs, in the County of Washington, except during the  
4 months of May, June and September of each year it shall  
5 be lawful to fish for and take trout in said pond in accord-

6 ance with the general law of the state relating to trout  
7 fishing. Provided, further, that no person shall fish for,  
8 take, catch or kill any kind of fish in said pond at any time  
9 on Sunday. Provided, further, that no person shall have  
10 in possession at any time any kind of fish taken in viola-  
11 tion of any provision of this section.

Whoever violates any provision of this act shall pay a  
13 fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than thirty dol-  
14 lars and costs for each offense; and in addition thereto one  
15 dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed or had in possession  
16 in violation of any provision of this act.
