## STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT additional to chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to fishing in Simpson pond, so-called, in the town of Roque Bluffs, in the County of Washington.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No person shall fish for, take, catch or kill any trout at 2 any time in Simpson pond, so-called, in the town of Reque 3 Bluffs, in the County of Washington, except during the

- 4 months of May, June and September of each year it shall
- 5 be lawful to fish for and take trout in said pond in accord-

6 ance with the general law of the state relating to trout 7 fishing. Provided, further, that no person shall fish for, 8 take, catch or kill any kind of fish in said pond at any time 9 on Sunday. Provided, further, that no person shall have 10 in possession at any time any kind of fish taken in violation of any provision of this section.

Whoever violates any provision of this act shall pay a 13 fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than thirty dol14 lars and costs for each offense; and in addition thereto one 15 dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed or had in possession 16 in violation of any provision of this act.
