STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT additional to chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to fishing in Fifteen Mile Stream and its tributaries in the County of Kennebec and in the County of Waldo.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall fish for, take, catch or kill 2 any kind of fish at any time in Fifteen Mile Stream or in 3 any of the tributaries to said stream, situated in the County 4 of Kennebec and in the County of Waldo; nor shall any 5 person have in possession at any time any kind of fish 6 taken in any of the above named waters.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall 2 pay a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than thirty 3 dollars and costs for each offense; and in addition thereto 4 one dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed or had in possession in violation of any provision of this act.
