RESOLVE providing for permanent outside service extension to present and proposed new buildings at the Maine School for Feeble-Minded.

---

*Resolved,* That there be and hereby is appropriated the  
2 sum of six thousand dollars, for the year nineteen hundred  
3 and fifteen, and the sum of six thousand dollars, for the  
4 year nineteen hundred and sixteen, for the use of the  
5 Maine School for Feeble-Minded, for outside service ex-  
6 tension to the present and the proposed new buildings, and  
7 that any of the appropriation for the year nineteen hun-  
8 dred and fifteen remaining unexpended at the end of said  
9 year, may be available for the year nineteen hundred and  
10 sixteen; said sum to be expended under the direction of  
11 the hospital trustees.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

When the present buildings were built, they were connected to the now abandoned heating plant by temporary steam pipes, which already require frequent repairing. Last fall when the new boiler was installed where the proposed power plant is to be built, the old steam service was extended to this boiler by temporary steam pipes. Permanent steam pipes should be laid from the new power and heating plant to the present buildings, and extended to the proposed new buildings. The present hot water service is inadequate for bathing purposes, and should be enlarged and extended to meet the demands of the institution. Extension of hydrant system for fire protection is an imperative necessity. The water main, and the electric and the sewer service, must be extended as new buildings are added.
