IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT Establishing a Close Time on Lobsters in the Waters of Jonesboro and Roque Bluffs, in Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1. No person shall take, catch, kill or destroy any
2 lobsters between the first day of July and the first day of
3 September in each year in any of the waters of Jonesboro
4 and Roque Bluffs in Washington County, and no person
5 shall set a trap within said waters for the purpose of tak6 ing, catching, killing or destroying any lobsters between
7 said dates, under a penalty of one dollar for each lobster
8 so taken, caught, killed or destroyed, and under a penalty
9 of five dollars for each lobster trap so set for such purpose. Sect. 2. All fines and penalties provided for by this act 2 may be recovered as provided by section forty-eight of 3 chapter two hundred and eighty-five of the public laws of 4 eighteen hundred and ninety-seven.
