STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT regulating the taking of clams in the Town of
Lamoine.

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person not a resi-
2 dent of the Town of Lamoine in the County of Hancock to
3 dig for clams within the limits of said town. This section
4 shall not interfere with any law relating to the taking of
5 shell fish for bait by fishermen.

Sect. 2. Whoever shall violate the provisions of section
2 1 of this act shall for each offense be punished by a fine of
3 not more than \$10.00 or by imprisonment for not more than
4 thirty days.
