### STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter sixty-two of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and five entitled An Act to protect cod and other ground fish in waters off the coast of Lincoln and Sagadahoc Counties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter sixty-two of the private and special
laws of nineteen hundred and five is amended by striking
out all of said section after the word "state" at the end of
the third line and adding the following: 'north of a line
drawn from the northern end of largest Five Islands in the
town of Georgetown to Hendricks Head light in the town
of Southport,' so that said section as amended shall read as
follows:

'Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, except 10 with trawls or ordinary hook and lines, any cod or other 11 ground fish from the waters subject to the jurisdiction of 12 this state, north of a line drawn from the northern end of 13 largest Five Islands in the town of Georgetown to Hen-14 dricks Head light in the town of Southport.'
