STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE for the purpose of providing and operating "Patrol Boats" to be used in enforcing the laws relating to Sea and Shore Fisheries.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated, the 2 sum of Nine Thousand Dollars, for the year Nineteen Hun-3 dred and Fifteen and Three Thousand Dollars for the year 4 Nineteen Hundred and Sixteen, in addition to the regular 5 and usual appropriation, for this department, for the pur-6 poses of purchasing and operating patrol boats to be used 7 along the coast, to carry wardens and other officials who are 8 engaged in enforcing the laws relative to Sea and Shore 9 Fisheries.

The Commissioner is authorized to purchase, in the name of the State suitable and proper power boats at a cost of not exceeding Six Thousand Dollars and may expend not exceeding Three Thousand Dollars per year for salaries of officials and wardens to operate said power boats and other necessary expenses.

The Commissioner in his report shall make a detailed state-17 ment of all money expended under this resolve.
