STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter one hundred thirty-
nine of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred
ninety-nine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter one hundred thirty-nine of the pri-
vate and special laws of eighteen hundred ninety-nine is
hereby amended so that said section as amended shall read
as follows:

Section 1. The land in the town of Dixfield embraced
within the following limits: Commencing at a point in the
center of Webb's river at the southwest corner of land owned
by the heirs of Tyler Kidder; thence easterly by the south-

9 erly line of said Kidder land to the easterly limit of the
10 county road leading from Dixfield village to Weld; thence
11 southerly along said road and bounded by it to the north-
12 west corner of house lot owned by Henry G. Thayer; thence
13 easterly along northerly line of said house lot to land owned
14 by Guy Judkins; thence easterly along northerly line of said
15 Judkins land to the northwest corner of Cyrus W. Bartlett
16 pasture; thence easterly by the said Bartlett's north line to
17 the homestead farm of George G. Gates; thence southwest-
18 erly on the line between said Bartlett pasture and said George
19 G. Gates' homestead farm to the road leading from Dix-
20 field village past the house of Leroy R. Hall, over the hill,
21 so called; thence easterly and southerly by said road to the
22 Ephraim Marble farm, thence southwesterly on the line be-
23 tween said Marble farm and said George G. Gates' home-
24 stead farm to the Androscoggin river, thence up the north-
25 erly bank of said Androscoggin river to Webb's river, thence
26 up said Webb's river to the bound begun at, together with
27 the inhabitants thereon, be and the same is hereby created
28 a body politic and corporate by the name of the Dixfield
29 Village Corporation.'
