STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of reimbursing the County Commissioners
of Penobscot County for cost of repairs to the State Bridge
between the towns of Old Town and Milford.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum
2 of three hundred and seven dollars and eighty-four cents
3 (\$307.84) to reimburse the county commissioners of Penob-
4 scot county for cost of repairs to the state bridge between
5 the towns of Old Town and Milford, during the years 1913
6 and 1914, under chapter 402 of the laws of 1907.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Under chapter 402, public laws of 1907, two wooden bridges between Old Town and Milford reverted to the state, with the provision that the commissioners of Penobscot county should make necessary repairs, under the supervision of the state highway commission, and be reimbursed by the state. Amount named in the resolve is cost of repairs made under the laws during the years 1913 and 1914.
