

## STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Old Town-Milford Bridge.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of \$3,500.00 to enable the state highway commission 3 to settle claims for land damage in connection with the 4 building of the easterly span of the Old Town-Milford 5 bridge.



#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The construction of this bridge has cost more than originally estimated on account of additional foundation work not contemplated when original plans and estimates were made.

All bills in connection with the construction of the bridge, except land damages, have been paid. At the present time there is outstanding one claim of \$2,000.00 in favor of Edson C. Brown, being an award by the county commissioners for damages.

There is also a claim of the Bangor Power Company for \$500.00 with a contingent liability, which it is estimated can be taken care of for \$1,000.00.

The above amount is asked for to settle these claims.
