STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend section fourteen of chapter four of the Revised Statutes relating to Town Agent.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section fourteen of chapter four of the revised statutes is

a horaby amended by striking out the words "town agent" in

- 3 the second line thereof and the following sentence at the
- 4 end thereof, "The town agent shall act under the direction
- 5 of the selectmen and shall receive from the treasury of the
- 6 town, such compensation for his services as may be fixed
- 7 by vote of the town; otherwise, as the selectmen shall allow."
- 8 And by adding the following: 'The board of selectmen shall
- 9 be the agent of the town in all matters not otherwise pro-

10 vided for by law or by vote of the town,' so that said section
11 as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 14. Moderator, town clerk, selectmen, assessors and 13 overseers of the poor, treasurer, auditor, school committee, 14 and road commissioners shall be elected by ballot, and the 15 other said officers by ballot, or if not so elected, they shall 16 be appointed by the selectmen. The board of selectmen 17 shall be the agent of the town in all matters not otherwise 18 provided for by law or by vote of the town.'
