### STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of Henry Golding for Military Pension.

Resolved, That Henry Golding of Gray be and hereby is 2 granted a military pension of twelve dollars per month, to 3 continue during the pleasure of the legislature.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Henry Golding of Gray served in the United States Navy about two years, was discharged as a landsman from the ship Franklin Nov. 13, 1871. He receives no pension whatever. His age is seventy-one years, his wife is sixty-two and has had two shocks. He also has two grown sons to support, neither of whom is capable of doing much towards helping the family. His only property is a small house worth about \$200. Mr. Golding is very infirm and is more or less dependent on charity.
