STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of Mary Harmon, Bangor, Maine.

*Resolved, That there be paid Mary Harmon of Bangor the
2 sum of ten dollars per month, payable quarterly from the
3 fund appropriated for military pensions, to begin January
4 first, nineteen hundred and fifteen, and continue during the
5 pleasure of the legislature.*

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The said Mary Harmon is the widow of John Harmon who served in Co. D, 25th Regiment of Infantry. She owns a small house worth about \$400.00 and has no other property. She is aged and infirm and cannot be left alone for any length of time. Her daughter has to stay at home and care for her. Mrs. Harmon is ninety-one years of age.
