

#### STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE for providing a State Pensions for Charles H. Kelley.

Resolved, That a pension of ten dollars a month be allowed 2 to Charles H. Kelley, who was injured while in service in 3 the navy, beginning with the first day of January, 1915, and 4 continuing during the pleasure of the legislature, and until 5 otherwise ordered.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Charles H. Kelley enlisted at Bar Harbor, Maine, August 9, 1905, and was discharged December 5, 1907, by reason of disability, and not recommended for re-enlistment. He was injured while in line of duty, hoisting out ashes, fell and injured his knee, and his left side is almost wholly paralyzed.
