# STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of Will T. Collins, Mary Collins and Alice A. Collins.

Resolved, That the sum of One Thousand Eight Hundred 2 and Fifty Dollars (\$1,850) be and hereby is appropriated 3 to be paid to Will T. Collins, Mary Collins and Alice A. 4 Collins, in payment for land and water rights taken under 5 the right of eminent domain by the Commissioners of Inland 6 Fisheries and Game for fish hatchery purposes and that fif-7 teen hundred dollars be paid from Inland Fish and Game 8 appropriation and three hundred and fifty dollars from gen-9 eral appropriation. ·

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Upon a petition filed with the Board of County Commissioners, for the County of Aroostook, the Inland Fisheries & Game Commission condemned a parcel of land in the town of Caribou, in the County of Aroostook, for the purpose of enlarging the State fish hatchery in that town. A hearing was held by the Commissioners, and damages were assessed, but no part of the same has ever been paid to the owners of the land. The amount assessed by the County Commissioners was \$1,500.
