STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to establish the offices of Superintendent and Matron
of the Portland City Home, and to determine the tenure of
office of same.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The present master and matron of the work
2 house and alms house and of the house of correction of the
3 city of Portland shall be continued in the service of the city
4 in their respective capacities for the term of five years from
5 the taking effect of this act, and shall be known and desig-
6 nated, respectively, as superintendent of Portland City Home
7 and matron of Portland City Home. The term of office
8 thereafter shall be five years, and until their successors are

9 chosen and qualified, such successors to be elected by the
10 board of overseers of the poor of the city of Portland.

Sect. 2. The overseers of the poor of the city of Port-
2 land shall fix the compensation of the superintendent and
3 matron of the Portland City Home.

Sect. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith
2 are hereby repealed.
