STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Augusta, Maine, Feb. 12, 1915.

Bates, widow of Jared Bates, late of Augusta, who was first enrolled on the 21st day of December, 1861, and last discharged the 17th day of June, 1865, wishes to be allowed the sum of ten dollars (\$10.00) each month. Hoping with the help of this amount to be able to pay burial expenses which were about four hundred dollars (\$400.00), and mortgage on home which is twenty-three hundred and forty dollars (\$2340.00) and also to educate two daughters.
