### STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of Meldon Nealley, Brewer, Maine.

Resolved, that there be paid Meldon Nealley of Brewer the

- 2 sum of ten dollars per month, payable quarterly from the
- 3 fund appropriated for Military pensions, to begin January
- 4 first, nineteen hundred and fifteen and continue during the
- 5 pleasure of the Legislature.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The said Meldon Nealley of Brewer served in the 2nd Maine regiment. Was injured in a railroad accident at Kennebunkport, Maine, on his return from the service. He being jammed between the cars in such a manner as to inflict injury to the back and head so severe as to necessitate his being confined to the bed three months. He has never fully recovered and since the accident has not been able to perform full manual labor. Applicant is only able with the assistance of his wife to support his family.
