STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE to provide for a celebration of the One Hundredth Anniversary of the State of Maine, and the Three Hundredth Anniversary of the Landing of the Pilgrims.

Resolved, That a committee of seven (7) persons be appointed from this Legislature, three by the President of the Senate, and four by the Speaker of the House, to be known as the Maine 1920 Legislative Committee, whose duty shall be to confer with the State Board of Trade 1920 Committee with the view of devising a plan for a celebration by the State of the One Hundredth Anniversary of the Admission of the State of Maine to the Union, and Three Hundredth Anniversary of the Landing of the Pilgrims.
