STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to Protect Agricultural and Horticultural Societies against Fraud.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Whoever shall gain admission to the grounds or buildings 2 of any Agricultural or Horticultural Society during the 3 holding of an exhibition otherwise than by the regular en-4 trance provided, for the purpose of defrauding such society 5 out of the regular entrance fee to such grounds or build-6 ings, or who by fraud, misrepresentation or otherwise un-7 lawfully obtains such admission, and any person obtaining 8 any premium or gratuity offered by such society by fraud 9 or misrepresentation, shall be deemed guilty of larceny

10 from such society, and on conviction shall be punished in 11 accordance with the Statutes made and provided in such 12 cases.
