STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Bath City Hospital was incorporated in 1907. It has no endowment and only a small amount of investment income, consequently it has to depend upon what it receives from the care of patients, from donations by citizens, and what aid it receives from the state.

It owns real estate to the value of about \$25,000 and furniture and fixtures to the value of about \$4500.

Jan. 1, 1914. Number of patients in hospital, 8; admitted, 274; discharged, 272; remaining, 10; treated, 282; males, 128; females, 154; cured, 220; improved, 27; not improved, 5; died, 20; died within 24 hours of admittance, 7.

Largest number of patients, 25; smallest, 5; daily average, 12; day's treatment, 4685; day's treatment, free, 1391.
