STATE

AN ACT additional to chapter 32 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 206 of the Public Laws of 1913, relating to fishing in Dead Cambridge river and other waters in Oxford county.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No person shall fish for, take, catch or kill any kind of fish

- 2 at any time, in Dead Cambridge river, in Upton and in
- 3 Township C Surplus, in Oxford county, from Umbagog
- 4 lake to C pond, or in C pond, in said Township C Surplus,
- 5 except by the ordinary method of casting with artificial flies
- 6 or fly fishing; nor shall any person fish for, take, catch or
- 7 kill any kind of fish at any time in any of the tributaries to

8 said Dead Cambridge river, except Swift Cambridge river. 9 or in any of the tributaries to said C pond.

No person shall have in possession at any time any kind of fish taken in violation of any provision of this act.

Whoever violates any provision of this act shall pay a fine 13 of not less than ten dollars nor more than thirty dollars and 14 costs for each offense; and in addition thereto one dollar for 15 each fish taken, caught, killed or had in possession for violation of any provision of this act.
