STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT additional to chapter thirty-two of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the public laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to ice fishing in Whetstone pond, in Piscataquis county.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall fish for, take, catch or kill any
2 kind of fish at any time on or through the ice in Whetstone
3 pond, in the towns of Kingsbury and Blanchard, in Piscata-
4 quis county, nor shall any person have in possession at any
5 time any kind of fish taken on or through the ice in said
6 pond.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of section one of
2 this act shall pay a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more

3 than thirty dollars and costs for each offense, and in addi-
4 tion thereto one dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed, or
5 had in possession in violation of any provision of said sec-
6 tion
