STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend section two of chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to ice fishing in Kingsbury pond, in Somerset and Piscataquis Counties, and in the Bennett ponds, so-called, in Guilford, in Piscataquis County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

So much of section two of chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, as prohibits fishing through the ice, in accordance with the general law of the State relating to ice fishing in that portion

6 of Kingsbury pond which is situated in Piscataquis County,
7 and in the Bennett ponds, so-called, in Guilford, in said
