AN ACT to amend section two of chapter 32 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 206 of the public laws of 1913, relating to ice fishing in Barker pond, in Cornville, in Somerset county.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

So much of section two of chapter thirty-two of the re
vised statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six

of the public laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, as pro
hibits fishing through the ice in Barker pond, in Cornville,

in Somerset county, in accordance with the general law of

the State relating to ice fishing, is hereby repealed.
