STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT additional to chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to fishing in Violette brook, in Van Buren, in the County of Aroostook, above Hammond's Mill.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No person shall fish for, take, catch or kill any kind of fish

- 2 at any time in Violette brook, in Van Buren, in the County
- 3 of Aroostook, above Hammond's Mill, nor shall any person
- 4 have in possession at any time any kind of fish taken in said
- 5 brook above said Hammond's Mill.

Whoever violates any provision of this act shall pay a fine

7 of not less than ten dollars nor more than thirty dollars and 8 costs of prosecution for each offense; and in addition there- 9 to one dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed or had in 10 possession in violation of any provision of this act.
