STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to fishing in Davis stream and Monson pond stream, in the county of Piscataquis.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows.

So much of section two of chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, as prohibits fishing in Davis stream, a tributary to Wilson stream, down as far as Hathaway brook, and in Monson pond

6 stream, a tributary to said Davis stream, said waters being
7 situated in the county of Piscataquis, in accordance with the
8 general law of the state, is hereby repealed.
