STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to authorize the construction of a public building in Rumford for municipal and county purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The municipal officers of the town of Rumford 2 are hereby authorized and directed to acquire a lot of land 3 in the town of Rumford suitable for a site for a public 4 building to be used by the county of Oxford for court pur-5 poses and by said town for municipal purposes, either by 6 purchase or by taking as for public uses, and said municipal 7 officers are further authorized and as soon as may be here-8 after shall proceed to construct on said lot such a building 9 which shall contain a town hall and other rooms needed by

the town of Rumford for municipal purposes and a court room, jury rooms and judges' chambers and other rooms 12 suitable for the accommodation of the supreme judicial 13 court, the Rumford Falls municipal court and the probate 14 court of said county, which shall be used by said county 15 for holding all the sessions of said courts that are by law 16 required to be held at said Rumford, and also shall provide 17 in said building a police station with suitable cells for the 18 use of the sheriff of the county of Oxford and his deputies 19 and of the police and constables in said county whenever 20 they may have occasion to detain prisoners at said Rumford.

- Sect. 2. For the above described use by said county of 2 Oxford of said building, said county shall pay to the town 3 of Rumford towards the purchase of said lot and the con-4 struction of said building twenty-five thousand dollars.
- Sect. 3. The town of Rumford shall pay towards the pur-2 chase of said lot and the construction of said building a sum 3 equal to or greater than said sum so paid by said county.
- Sect. 4. The county commissioners of Oxford county are 2 hereby authorized and directed as soon as the municipal 3 officers of the town of Rumford have procured a suitable 4 lot for said building to pay said sum of twenty-five thou-5 sand dollars in cash to said municipal officers and in order 6 to procure the whole or any part of said sum, said county 7 commissioners are hereby authorized to borrow money tem-8 porarily and to issue therefor the interest-bearing negoti-9 able notes of said county, and for the purpose of paying or

10 refunding the indebtedness so created said county commis-11 sioners may from time to time issue the interest-bearing 12 bonds of such county for a sum not exceeding twenty-five 13 thousand dollars.

Sect. 5. In order to carry out the provisions of this 2 act in the purchase of said land and in the construction of 3 said building the municipal officers of Rumford are hereby 4 authorized to borrow money temporarily and to issue there-5 for the interest-bearing negotiable notes of said town, and 6 for the purpose of paying or refunding the indebtedness 7 so created said municipal officers may from time to time 8 issue the interest-bearing bonds of said town for a sum not 9 exceeding forty-five thousand dollars, provided the indebt-10 edness so created shall not exceed the legal debt limit of said 11 town.

Sect. 6. The purpose of this act is to enable the county 2 commissioners of the county of Oxford to carry out the 3 provisions of chapter 47 of the public laws of 1907 for the 4 care of the term of the supreme judicial court therein automorized to be held at Rumford and to provide more adequate 6 accommodations for said supreme judicial court, the Rumford Falls municipal court and the probate court at all the 8 sessions of said courts required to be held at Rumford and 9 for all other purposes herein expressed, and said county 10 shall have the free use of the portions of said building intended for the accommodation of said county so long as the 12 same may be used by the county.
