STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT additional to and to amend section two of chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to fishing in Kennebago lake, Little Kennebago lake and the outlets of said lakes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall take, catch and kill in any one
2 day more than ten fish in all in Kennebago lake or in Little
3 Kennebago lake or in Little Kennebago Stream; nor shall
4 any person have in possession in any one day more than
5 ten fish in all taken in any of the above named waters.

Whoever violates any provision of this section shall pay

7 a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than thirty dol-
8 lars and costs for each offense; and in addition thereto one
9 dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed, destroyed or had
10 in possession in violation of any provision of this section.

Sect. 2. So much of section two of chapter thirty-two of
2 the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred
3 and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thir-
4 teen, as prohibits a person from carrying to his home in
5 one day five fish, or not more than three pounds of fish (un-
6 less an individual fish exceeds three pounds in weight)
7 which he has legally taken in the above named lakes or in
8 Little Kennebago stream or in the portion of Kennebago
9 stream which is open to fishing, is hereby repealed.
