STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NING HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend chapter 32 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 206 of the public laws of 1913, relating to fishing in Belgrade stream, a tributary to Snow pond, in the county of Kennebec.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall fish for, take, catch or kill any

- 2 kind of fish at any time in Belgrade stream, a tributary to
- 3 Snow pond, in the County of Kennebec, from Long pond to
- 4 Belgrade Bridge, so-called, on said stream.

No person shall have in possession any kind of fish taken

6 in violation of any provision of this section.

Whoever violates any provision of this section shall pay a 8 fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than thirty dol-

- 9 lars and costs for each offense; and in addition thereto one 10 dollar for each fish taken, caught, kill, or had in possession 11 in violation of any provision of this section.
 - Sect. 2. So much of section two of chapter thirty-two of 2 the revised statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred 3 and six of the public laws of nineteen hundred and thir-4 teen, as is inconsistent with the provisions of this act, is 5 hereby repealed.
