STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Carrabassett Dam Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter 125 of the private laws of the year one thousand nine hundred and seven, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Carrabassett Dam Company," is hereby amended by adding to section two thereof the following words: 'provided, however, that the Commissioners of Inland Fisheries and Game may cause the gates of the Caribou Valley Dam to be raised and kept open from time to time to facilitate the passage of fish for such periods during any season as will not interfere with the use of said dam for the purposes above stated, or with the proper main-

11 tenance and safety of said dam,' so that said section, when
12 amended, will read as follows:

'Sect. 2. Said company is hereby authorized to erect
14 and maintain, on the Carrabassett river and the tributaries
15 flowing into said river, above the forks of said Carrabassett
16 river in the town of New Portland, in the townships of
17 Mount Abraham, Crockertown, Treadwell plantation and
18 the town of Kingfield, dams, side dams and piers, and to
19 remove rocks and trees, and to excavate ledges, and to
20 widen, deepen and otherwise improve said Carrabassett
21 river, from the Kennebec river to the head waters of the
22 said Carrabassett river, and upon its tributaries, for the
23 purpose of raising a head of water to make such river and
24 its tributaries floatable, and to facilitate the driving of logs,
25 lumber and pulp wood down the same. Provided, however,
26 that the Commissioners of Inland Fisheries and Game may
27 cause the gates of the Caribou Valley Dam to be raised and
28 kept open from time to time to facilitate the passage of
29 fish for such periods during any season as will not interfere
30 with the use of said dam for the purposes above stated, or
31 with the proper maintenance and safety of said dam.
