STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to increase the powers of the County Commissioners
of Penobscot County in regard to making temporary loans,
additional to Chapter 80 of the Revised Statutes of 1903.

Whereas, it is the opinion of the county commissioners of
Penobscot county after careful consideration of the matter
that there is not sufficient funds in the county treasury at this
time to pay the current bills, and whereas no means have been
provided for raising the additional funds to meet these current
expenses and other necessary expenses during the next few
months; and whereas the interest of the people in Penobscot
County demands that these current and necessary expenses be
paid as they become due, and unless this act is passed as an

emergency act it cannot take effect until approximately July 1, 1915, an emergency, therefore, exists, and the public peace, health and safety will be conserved by empowering the county commissioners of said county to borrow an additional sum for the above purposes, and now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The county commissioners of Penobscot county
2 may, without obtaining the consent of the county, raise by
3 temporary loan, to be paid within one year from the time
4 when the same is contracted, a sum not exceeding twenty-
5 five thousand dollars in any year for use of said county and
6 cause notes or obligations of said county, with coupons for
7 lawful interest, to be issued for payment thereof, as afore-
8 said.

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts, in and so far as they
2 conflict with the above, are hereby repealed.
