RESOLVE in favor of Mary A. Moulton of Cushing, Maine.

---

*Resolved,* That there be paid to Mary A. Moulton of Cushing \$8.00 per month, payable quarterly from the state pension fund for soldiers, to begin January first, nineteen hundred and fifteen, and continue during the pleasure of the legislature.



#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The said Mary A. Moulton is the widow of Darius Moulton, who served in Co. F of the 11th Regiment, Maine Infantry. Mrs. Moulton has a farm in Cushing worth about six hundred dollars, mortgaged for three hundred and fifty dollars. She is in very poor health and unable to do any hard work. She has a son six years of age dependent upon her, also a mother fifty-six years of age who is destitute of property. Mrs. Moulton is thirty-seven years of age.
