STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT relating to scaling round timber and marking the contents on same.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Any person measuring round timber the quantity of which
2 is estimated by the thousand shall scale the same and mark
3 upon each log surveyed by him the contents thereof, unless
4 otherwise agreed by the parties contracting.
