RESOLVE in favor of Ozias M. Goff of Gray, Maine.

---

*Resolved,* That Ozias M. Goff of Gray, Maine, be allowed  
2 to tap the water main for a supply of water for his farm  
3 buildings in Gray, Maine, as compensation to satisfy his  
4 claim for damages caused by laying of water main to  
5 School for Feeble-Minded. The connection to be made  
6 under the supervision of the engineer in the employ of the  
7 School for Feeble-Minded. The amount of water taken  
8 not to exceed one thousand gallons each twenty-four hours.

Provided that a water meter may be installed at any time  
10 when considered necessary by the trustees of said School  
11 for Feeble-Minded.
