STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to provide for the destruction of dog-fish and other members of the shark species.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. That the Governor and Council be hereby au-

- 2 thorized to appoint a commission of three practical men
- 3 who shall thoroughly investigate the question of the de-
- 4 struction of dog-fish and other members of the shark family
- 5 in the waters of Maine and report to the next Legislature
- 6 some feasible plan for extermination of this very destruc-
- 7 tive fish.

- Sect. 2. That this said commission shall be empowered to 2 ask Congress and other States to take this matter in hand 3 and pass legislation as will enable said commissioners with 4 such other commissioners as may be appointed to success-5 fully co-operate on this question.
- Sect. 3. That the sum of one thousand dollars is hereby 2 appropriated annually for the next two years to defray the 3 expenses of said commission having this matter in charge.
- Sect. 4. Whereas it appears that an emergency exists for 2 the carrying into effect the provisions in Section one, this 3 Act shall take effect when approved.
