STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section 35 of Chapter 114 of the Revised Statutes, relating to a relief of poor debtors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section thirty-five, chapter one hundred fourteen of the 2 revised statutes, is hereby amended by inserting therein 3 after the word "attend" in the second line thereof the fol-4 lowing: 'any justice of the peace may continue the case not 5 exceeding twice or,' so that said section as amended shall 6 read as follows:

'Sect. 35. In case the magistrate who issued the summons 8 is unable to attend any justice of the peace may continue 9 the case not exceeding twice or any other magistrate quali10 fied to take disclosures may attend and take the disclosure, 11 and, for cause shown by either party, the examination may 12 be adjourned from time to time.'
