STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend chapter thirty-one of the Private and Special
Laws of nineteen hundred and five, entitled "An Act to au-
thorize the Houlton Water Company to generate, sell and
distribute electricity," as amended by chapter one hundred
and six of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred
and seven.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section four of chapter thirty-one of the private and spe-
2 cial laws of nineteen hundred and five, as amended by chap-
3 ter one hundred and six of the private and special laws of
4 nineteen hundred and seven, is hereby further amended by
5 adding in line three after the word "aforesaid" thereof the

6 words 'and for the purposes specified and stated in chapter
7 three hundred and forty-eight of the private and special
8 laws of nineteen hundred and nine and for the purpose of
9 purchasing the plant and business of any person, partner-
10 ship or corporation carrying on or doing any electric busi-
11 ness in the town of Houlton,' and by striking out the word
12 "forty" in line four of said section four and inserting in
13 lieu thereof the words 'one hundred and twenty,' and by
14 striking out the word "forty" in the sixth and seventh lines
15 thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the words 'one hun-
16 dred,' so that said section four, as amended, shall read as fol-
17 lows:

'Sect. 4. Said company or corporation may lease, pur-
19 chase, acquire and hold real and personal estate, necessary
20 and convenient for the purposes aforesaid and for the pur-
21 poses specified and stated in chapter three hundred and
22 forty-eight of the private and special laws of nineteen hun-
23 dred and nine, and for the purpose of purchasing the plant
24 and business of any person, partnership or corporation carry-
25 ing on or doing any electric business in the town of Houl-
26 ton, to an amount not exceeding one hundred and twenty
27 thousand dollars; may sell and convey the same; and may
28 issue, negotiate and sell its bonds to an amount not exceed-
29 ing one hundred thousand dollars for the purposes stated
30 in this act, and said bonds to the amount of one hundred
31 thousand dollars may be purchased and held by the savings
32 banks and trust companies of Maine.'
