STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend section seven of chapter one hundred and eighty-one of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and eleven, entitled "An Act to Establish in Cumberland County a County Farm."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section seven of chapter one hundred and eighty-one of
2 the private and special laws of nineteen hundred eleven is
3 hereby amended by adding the words, 'Every sentence of
4 imprisonment of a male offender for intoxication after the
5 first day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand
6 nine hundred and sixteen in the county of Cumberland may

7 be to the county farm of that county, providing that a sen-
8 tence for first offense may be governed by the preceding
9 parts of this section or by the general laws of this state,'
10 so that said section when amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 7. When a man is sentenced to be imprisoned on
12 the county farm, the judge or trial justice proposing sen-
13 tence shall not prescribe the length of sentence other than
14 it shall not be for less than three months nor more than
15 one year. When a man is so sentenced to be imprisoned
16 on the county farm, he shall be held and employed thereon
17 for not more than one year. Every sentence of imprison-
18 ment of a male offender for intoxication after the first day
19 of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hun-
20 dred and sixteen in the county of Cumberland may be to
21 the county farm of that county; providing that a sentence
22 for the first offense may be governed by the preceding parts
23 of this section or by the general laws of this state.'
