STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section 17 of Chapter 80 of the Revised Statutes, relating to the powers of the County Commissioners of Cumberland County.

Bc it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 17 of chapter 80 of the revised statutes is hereby

- 2 amended by striking out in the fourth line thereof the word
- 3 "fifty," and inserting in lieu thereof the words 'seventy-
- 4 five,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 17. The county commissioners of Cumberland coun-

- 6 ty may, without obtaining the consent of the county, raise
- 7 by temporary loan, to be paid within one year from the
- 8 time when the same is contracted, a sum not exceeding sev-

9 enty-five thousand dollars in any year for use of said county 10 and cause notes or obligations of said county, with coupons 11 for lawful interest, to be issued for payment thereof, as 12 aforesaid.'
