STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to create a Commission to act in conjunction with the State Armory Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The Inspector General and Charles H. Osgood of Lewis-

- 2 ton are hereby created a commission with power to act un-
- 3 der the direction of the Adjutant General and in conjunc-
- 4 tion with the State Armory Commission to determine the
- 5 feasibility of erecting armories at Lewiston and in other
- 6 parts of the State at the expense of the Sate; to inquire in-
- 7 to the probable cost of the same; to inspect such plans as
- 8 may be submitted to them in connection therewith and to

9 gather such information as may be obtained, and report the 10 results of their investigations to the next legislature. Com11 pensation and allowance for each day actually employed 12 shall be the same as that provided for members of the Arm13 ory Commission by Section 95, Chapter 206, Public Laws 14 of 1909.
