STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to create a Commission to act in conjunction with the
State Armory Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The Inspector General and Charles H. Osgood of Lewis-
2 ton are hereby created a commission with power to act un-
3 der the direction of the Adjutant General and in conjunc-
4 tion with the State Armory Commission to determine the
5 feasibility of erecting armories at Lewiston and in other
6 parts of the State at the expense of the State; to inquire in-
7 to the probable cost of the same; to inspect such plans as
8 may be submitted to them in connection therewith and to

9 gather such information as may be obtained, and report the
10 results of their investigations to the next legislature. Com-
11 pensation and allowance for each day actually employed
12 shall be the same as that provided for members of the Arm-
13 ory Commission by Section 95, Chapter 206, Public Laws
14 of 1909.
