RESOLVE in favor of Dana H. Danforth, secretary of Committee on School for Feeble-Minded, for the expenses of that Committee in visiting School for Feeble-Minded at New Gloucester.

Resolved, That there be paid to Dana H. Danforth, secretary of Committee on School for Feeble-Minded, the sum of fifty dollars (50), the same being the expenses incurred by the Committee in visiting the Maine School for Feeble Minded at New Gloucester.
