STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT relating to the Vinalhaven Lighting Co.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Vinalhaven Lighting Co., a corporation

- 2 organized under the general law, shall have full power and
- 3 authority to sell and convey to any corporation authorized
- 4 to do a lighting business in said Vinalhaven, all its property,
- 5 rights and franchises, together with its license, permission
- 6 and right to occupy the streets and ways in said town, with
- 7 poles, wires and pipes for the distribution of electricity, light
- 8 and power; and any such company is authorized to pur-
- 9 chase the same.

Sect. 2. When the conveyance provided for in Section 1

- 2 hereof shall be made, the grantee shall succeed to all the
- 3 rights and powers of said Vinalhaven Lighting Co., and the
- 4 right to occupy the streets, so conveyed, is hereby declared
- 5 to be legal and valid, and confirmed in such grantee, to-
- 6 gether with all powers incidental to the supplying, furnish-
- 7 ing and distributing electricity for heat, light and other pur-
- 8 poses within such territory as said grantee may be author-
- 9 ized under its charter to distribute the same.
- Sect. 3. Such grantee shall have authority to mortgage
- 2 all franchises and rights so purchased by it, as well as its
- 3 own franchises, rights and property; such transfer and
- 4 mortgage to be subject to the provisions of the public utili-
- 5 ties act.
