STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE providing for steel filing cases in the office of the
State Treasurer.

Resolved, that the sum of fifteen hundred dollars be and
2 hereby is appropriated for the purpose of installing steel
3 filing cases in the office of the State Treasurer, said appro-
4 priation to be expended during the year 1915, and should
5 any part of said appropriation remain unexpended at the
6 end of said time, it shall not lapse but may be expended in
7 the succeeding year.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Steel filing cases are much needed to complete the filing system in the vault in the State Treasury. Much valuable matter is now unclassified and without index and is stored in various part of the capitol. There still remains a good deal of pine shelving in the vault which should be replaced with steel, thus providing better protection to valuable papers and state funds.
