**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN**

AN ACT for the temporary licensing of Automobiles and Mo-
tor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The Secretary of State is hereby authorized to keep on
2 sale in such cities and towns as he may select, with the Chief
3 of Police or such persons as he may designate, tags that can
4 be attached to automobiles or motor vehicles in a conspicu-
5 ous place; and when said tags are attached, properly filled
6 out and signed, said automobiles or motor vehicles may be
7 operated seven days from the date on said tag, in the same
8 manner as those bearing the regular plates furnished by the
9 State.

The fee to be collected for such tags shall be One Dollar

11 and this shall be placed in the same funds as money received
12 for other licenses of motor vehicles, and used for the same
13 purposes.

The penalty for using a tag after the time limit has expired
15 shall be the same as applied to unlicensed automobiles or
16 motor vehicles.
