STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the State Highway Commission.

Whereas, under the direction of the state highway commission concrete bridges have been and are being erected in this state and in connection with the erection of said bridges, the question of infringement of certain patents has been raised, and,

Whereas, a suit involving this question has been brought against the town of Falmouth in which suit matters of importance to many towns in the state are in issue,

Be it resolved, that the state highway commission is hereby 2 authorized to undertake the defense of said suit on behalf 3 of said town of Falmouth, to employ counsel and do any 4 and all other things necessary in connection with said suit 5 with the same authority as though the suit were brought

6 against said commission, and the sum of two thousand 7 (2000) dollars is hereby appropriated to carry out the pur-8 poses of this resolve.
