STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section Four of Chapter Seventy-three of
the Revised Statutes Relating to Notices upon Petitions for
Sale of Real Estate.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section four of chapter seventy-three of the revised stat-
utes is hereby amended by inserting after the word "state"
in the fifth line of said section, the following words: 'or the
real estate is situated in a county other than the county in
which the proceedings are pending,' so that said section as
amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 4. No license shall be granted for the sale of any
real estate, of the value of more than fifty dollars, unless
by written consent of all persons interested therein, until

10 after public or personal notice of the time and place of hear-
11 ing, to all such persons, to appear and object if they see
12 cause. If any party interested resides without the state, or
13 the real estate is situated in a county other than the county
14 in which the proceedings are pending, such special notice
15 may be given as the court directs.'
