STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to Confer Jurisdiction in Equity upon the Probate Courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The courts of probate shall have jurisdiction in equity 2 concurrent with the supreme judicial court of all cases and

3 matters relating to the administration of the estates of de-

4 ceased persons, to wills, and to trusts which are created by

5 will or other written instrument. Such jurisdiction may

6 be exercised upon bill or petition according to the usual

7 course of proceedings in equity.
